



GOL Announces Traffic Statistics for March 2007

São Paulo, April 3, 2007 - GOL Linhas Aéreas Inteligentes (NYSE: GOL and Bovespa: GOLL4), Brazil's low fare, low cost airline, today released preliminary passenger statistics for the month of March 2007. System-wide passenger traffic (RPK) increased 43% and capacity (ASK) increased 59% year-over-year. GOL's system load factor for the month of March 2007 was 62%.

Domestic passenger traffic (RPK) for March increased 33% and capacity (ASK) increased 47%. GOL's domestic load factor for the month of March 2007 was 62%. International passenger traffic (RPK) for March increased 133% and capacity (ASK) increased 175%. International load factor for the month of March 2007 was 59%. Average fares were reduced approximately 24% versus March 2006.

(1) *Available seat kilometers* represents the aircraft seating capacity multiplied by the number of kilometers the seats are flown.

(2) *Revenue passenger kilometers* represents the numbers of kilometers flown by revenue passengers.

(3) *Load factor* represents the percentage of aircraft seating capacity that is actually utilized (calculated by dividing revenue passenger kilometers by available seat kilometers).

During 1Q07, GOL launched 12 new domestic flights and 10 new international flights. During 1Q07, planned capacity additions facilitated an increase in ASKs of approximately 61% versus 1Q06. During the quarter, GOL incorporated into its fleet two Boeing 737 aircraft. RPKs in 1Q07 increased approximately 60% versus 1Q06. Preliminary figures for the first quarter show that GOL achieved a load factor of approximately 70%, a passenger yield of approximately R\$20 cents, and net operating revenues per ASK ("RASK") of approximately R\$15 cents. Operating expenses per ASK decreased approximately 9% in the quarter and, for 1Q07, the Company estimates an operating cost per ASK ("CASK") of approximately R\$13.4 cents.
